

PRIVACY NOTICE RELATING TO MEMBER DATA

This privacy notice explains what Cycling UK Oxfordshire (the Club) does with the personal data that it collects from members and it outlines Club member's rights concerning those data. The Club's data protection policy is written to comply with the GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation).

The Club's use of your personal information

The Club holds ONLY the personal contact information (Name, address and email) that you have given Cycling UK (or that you have provided subsequently to the Club) in order to:

Carry out the activities associated with the normal running of the Club such as informing you of Club rides in our area.

What the Club does not do with your data

The Club does not:

- Pass on member data to any third party organisation or individual
- Carry out any automated decision-making or profiling based on members' data.
- Hold any 'sensitive personal data' on members as defined by the GDPR.

Storage of your personal information

The personal information about Club members is securely stored on a File Server that is password protected and only accessible to the following current Officers of the Club: Chairman, Secretary and Registration Officer.

Access to your personal information

As a Club member, you have the right to see the personal data that the Club holds on you. If there are any mistakes in the information that the Club holds about you, you have the right to have the mistakes corrected.

If you think that the Club's collection or use of information is unfair, misleading or inappropriate please contact the Club as detailed below.
